

## **Seasonal Sites**

A number of campsites at Quinn Lake have been designated "Seasonal Sites". The intent of the designation is to provide sites in a variety of locations to enable and encourage families to spend extended periods of time at the campground while preserving the majority of sites for campers who choose to spend only part of their vacations at the facility. A map of the designated sites is attached: 15 of the designated sites may be reserved in any year. All waterfront sites are available only on a daily fee basis.

How do I reserve a site?

Procedure for the Lottery for Seasonal Campsites at the Parry Sound Campground

1. The procedure will be effective immediately.
2. The first day for accepting calls (416.966.3424 or 1-800-268-7061) fax (416.966.5450) or emails will be the first Monday of December at 12:00 a.m. (Midnight). The last day for entry in the lottery will be the second Monday of December at close of business (5:00 p.m.).
3. All those who contact OTF looking to reserve a seasonal site will be asked to list those sites they would find acceptable in order of preference. Applicants may list any number of sites between one and fifteen.
4. The lottery will take place at 9:00 a.m. on the second Wednesday of December, at the OTF offices, with the Director assigned and two support staff members present.
5. The first name drawn will get her or his first choice.
6. The second name drawn will get her or his first available choice.
7. In the event that an applicant's name is drawn after her or his list of acceptable sites is exhausted, the draw will move on to the next applicant. The applicant whose list has been exhausted will be notified that none of the requested sites were available.
8. Drawing will continue until the maximum fifteen sites have been assigned or, should there be less than fifteen names in the lottery, until all those entered in the lottery either have sites or have been eliminated since none of the requested sites were available.
9. Payment for the site is due upon notification
10. Any sites remaining following the lottery will be available on a first-come first-served basis.

How much does a seasonal site cost?

Sites on the North side of the lake are rented at the equivalent of 40 times the daily rate. South side sites (pit toilets, no running water) can be rented for \$600.

Conditions and expectations for seasonal sites.

1. A seasonal site is available only to the family named on the agreement under the same conditions as daily sites (2 adults, up to 4 children). Additional adults and/or children must register as visitors and will be subject to the same surcharge as for daily sites. Lessees are asked to notify registrar if they will be absent for a period of time.

2. You may move your camping equipment onto the site anytime from May 1 (weather permitting), and it must be removed by the Tuesday following Thanksgiving Day.

3. Seasonal rental is specific to the lessee (see 1 above). Others "borrowing" the site in your absence must pay daily fees. (Normal conditions of eligibility and sponsorship apply to seasonal sites.)

4. Visitors must register upon arrival. The lessee is responsible for arranging the surcharge payment for additional guests (beyond 2 adults on site).

P1 Near pine point, shade,

PD2 open area near dock, large site

PD1, PD3, PD4, PD5, PD6, PD7 Along Parkside

ML1 large open site on beachside near office

B6 small site near beach and washroom
