

Seasonal Sites at Parry Sound Campground

A number of campsites have been designated “Seasonal Sites.” The intent is to provide sites in a variety of locations to enable and encourage families to spend extended periods of time at the campground. At the same time, we will preserve the majority of sites for campers who choose to spend only part of their vacations at the campground.

For a map of the designated sites, [click here](#). Fifteen of the designated sites circled on the map) may be reserved in any year. Note that all waterfront sites are available only on a daily fee basis.

Lottery to reserve a site

1. The first day for accepting calls or emails is the first Monday of December at 12:01 a.m. Click here for phone and email information.
2. The last day for entry in the lottery is the second Monday of December at close of business (5:00 p.m.).
3. All those who contact OTF looking to reserve a seasonal site will be asked to list those sites they would find acceptable in order of preference. Applicants may list any number of sites between one and fifteen.
4. All entries must be accompanied by a valid phone number or email address so that applicants can be notified of the lottery results. Failure to provide this information may void an entry.
5. The lottery will take place at 9:00 a.m. on the second Wednesday of December at the OTF office, with the Director assigned and two support staff members present.
6. The first name drawn will get her or his first choice.
7. The second name drawn will get her or his first available choice.
8. In the event that an applicant’s name is drawn after her or his list of acceptable sites is exhausted, the draw will move on to the next applicant. The applicant whose list has been exhausted will be notified that none of the requested sites were available.
9. Drawing will continue until the maximum 15 sites have been assigned or, should there be less than 15 names in the lottery, until all those entered in the lottery either have sites or have been eliminated since none of the requested sites were available.
10. Payment for the site is due upon notification.

11. Any sites remaining following the lottery will be available on a first-come first-served basis.

Cost of a seasonal site

Sites on the north side of the lake are rented at the equivalent of 40 times the daily rate. Sites on the south side (pit toilets, no running water) can be rented for \$600.

Conditions and expectations for seasonal sites

1. A seasonal site is available only to the family named on the agreement under the same conditions as daily sites (2 adults, up to 4 children). Additional adults and/or children must register as visitors and will be subject to the same surcharge as for daily sites. Lessees are asked to notify registrar if they will be absent for a period of time.
2. You may move your camping equipment on to the site at any time after May 1 (weather permitting). It must be removed by the Tuesday following Thanksgiving Day.
3. Seasonal rental is specific to the lessee (see 1 above). Others "borrowing" the site in your absence must pay daily fees. Normal conditions of eligibility and sponsorship apply to seasonal sites.
4. Visitors must register upon arrival. The lessee is responsible for arranging the surcharge payment for additional guests (beyond 2 adults on site).

Identified sites: 15 of the 20 offered may be leased in any single camping season

C1, C2, C3, C4: Cabin side

G2 and G1: Ghetto, morning shade

LD7, LD9, LD10: Near lakeshore, little shade but good view

P1: Near pine point, shade,

S2, S15, S17, W3, W7: Away from water, large shaded sites

PD2: Open area near dock, large site

PD1, PD3, PD4, PD5, PD6, PD7: Along park side

ML1: Large open site on beach side near office

B6: Small site near beach and washroom
