



## Arts-related Conferences and Workshops

### Arts Related Workshops

The Professional Learning through the Arts subsidy applies to registration fees (up to \$200) for workshops or other professional learning offered by subject specific arts associations (AFEAO, CODE, OMEA, OSEA) or other organizations provided the content is directly linked to the newly revised Ontario Curriculum; The Arts, Grades 1-8 and The Arts, Grades 9-12.

Some examples of arts related workshops offered through the OTF summer programs:

- Integrated Arts
- Going Green
- OSEA camp
- CODE camp
- OMEA camps

#### GENERAL

All professional learning experiences must be directly linked to the implementation of the revised Ontario Curriculum: The Arts, Grades 1-8 and The Arts, Grades 9-12 in order to qualify for the \$200 subsidy.

Individual arts experiences such as attending a performance, taking private lessons or enrolling in classes other than workshops do not qualify. The subsidy only applies to registration fees OR release time to attend the workshop. Travel, accommodation, meals etc., are not eligible for the subsidy.

Interested members must apply for the subsidy online and will receive immediate notification by return email that OTF has received their application.

Subsidies will be allocated on a first-come first-served basis.

When a member provides confirmation of attendance at an arts-based workshop, he/she will be reimbursed.
