What is INFORMAL Language?

- Informal language is mostly spoken.
- It is natural or "real-life" talking (or writing).
- Contractions (don't, shouldn't, it's, couldn't) are informal language.

Definition

• Language that is used in everyday situations and by people who know each other.

When to Use Informal Language

- Emails or texts to friends and family.
- Postcards or letters to friends and family.
- Everyday talk.
- Talk in the hallways at school.

When Not to Use Informal Language

- Important written work such as an essay for English class should not use informal language.
- When speaking to important people or in an important situation you should not use informal language.

People

- Friends.
- Family.
- Work mates.
- Neighbours.
- Shop keepers.
- Persons of equal "rank" or status.
