

- Slang is spoken language.
- Slang uses idiom
- An idiom is using a word to mean something other than its actual definition.
- For example, “chill” is a slang idiom meaning to relax.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>Language that uses very casual or made up words and phrases.</i>
When to Use Informal Language
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● When using some forms of social media with people you know and trust. ● When socializing with teenage friends.
When Not to Use Informal Language
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Do not use slang at school with your teachers. ● Do not use slang with your parents/guardians. ● Do not use slang with the parents/guardians of your friend / boyfriend / girlfriend. ● Do not use slang or swear words at work. ● Never use slang or swear words in any situation where you want to make a good impression. ● Do not use slang or swear words if you wish to be seen as a serious and polite person.
