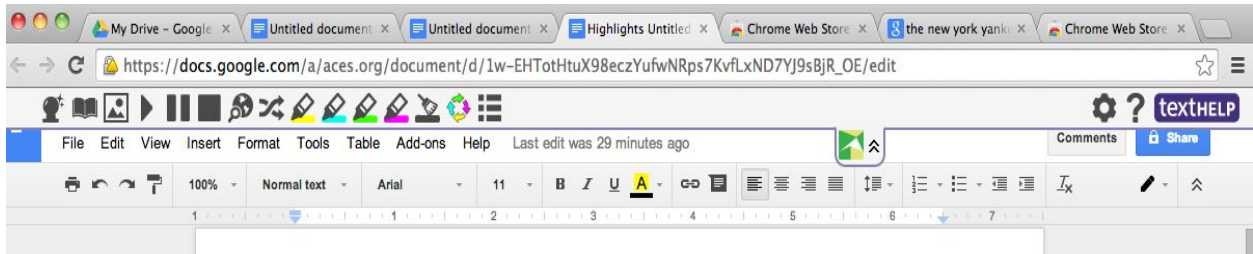

Worksheet Using Google Read & Write App! *The Cage*

Follow the instructions listed below to help you get familiarized with the Google Read & Write App. You will need to log on to our Google Classroom to access the short story *The Cage* by Riley H. Welker.



1. Before you start reading move your mouse over highlighted words and click on the Dictionary icon or the Picture icon to get a better understanding of what the word means.
2. During reading - press the play button and have the story read to you.
3. Once you are done reading go back and select 3 to 5 additional words that you didn't quite understand and find their definition.
4. Using the highlighters above identify four parts of a plot:
 - a. Blue (Introduction - who's this story about)
 - b. Pink (Conflict - what gets the story going - and inciting incident)
 - c. Yellow (Climax - the most exciting part of the story)
 - d. Green (Resolution - how does the story end)
5. Once you have completed step 4, press the collect highlight button to collect your designated highlighted areas.
