

TLLP 2018-19 Timelines

Oct. – Nov. 2017:	Boards and education partners promote the TLLP to experienced teachers
November 24, 2017:	Due date for eligible teachers to submit application to the director of education/supervisory officer of school authority. Director of education/supervisory officer of school authority forwards applications to the board level review committee
December 8, 2017:	Due date for board level review committee to submit two recommended proposals, and the applicant names and project titles of other applications received to the attention of the Teaching Policy and Standards Branch of the Ministry of Education (TLLP-PALPE@ontario.ca)
December 2017:	Board sends acknowledgement letter to teacher applicants
January 2018:	Applications reviewed by the Teacher Learning and Leadership Committee (TLLC)
March 2018:	The ministry sends decision letters to selected applicants (copies also sent to the board)
May 2018:	The ministry and Ontario Teachers' Federation hold the <i>Leadership Skills for Classroom Teachers</i> professional development session for selected participants
June 2018:	Project funding flowed to boards
June 2018 –June 2019:	Teachers implement project learning and sharing activities
April 2019:	Participants who would like more time to carry out their project learning and sharing goals can apply for a project extension (TLLP-PALPE@ontario.ca)
June 28, 2019:	Due date for teacher participants to submit the TLLP Teacher Participant Final Report Form to the director of education/supervisory officer of school authority and the Teaching Policy and Standards Branch (TLLP-PALPE@ontario.ca)
July 31, 2019:	Due date for director of education/supervisory officer of school authority to submit the TLLP Board Final Report Form to the ministry
November 2019:	The ministry and Ontario Teachers' Federation hold the <i>TLLP Sharing the Learning Summit</i> for selected participants
