

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT SUBMISSION DEADLINES

The school year in Canada runs from September to June.

Requests for funding from the OTF International Assistance Fund will not be processed during the summer months (June-August). Applications will only be accepted commencing September 15.



Deadlines for applications

The International Assistance Committee meets twice a year to consider applications for project funding.

- First meeting takes place in early December.
 Applications must be received no later than
 November 1.
- **Second meeting** takes place in early June. Applications must be received **no later than May 1.**

If your application is received by OTF after the deadline date for the first meeting (November 1), it will be held on file for consideration at the second meeting.

If your application is received by OTF after the deadline date for the second meeting (May 1), it will not be carried forward to the next fiscal/budget year. A new application must be submitted.

Communication of funding decisions

All applicants will be contacted approximately one month following the meeting at which the project request has been considered to let them know the outcome of the Committee's decision.

SECTION 5 - APPLICATIONS FROM INDIA ONLY

Due to recent changes in Indian banking procedures and FCRA requirements, it is currently proving to be almost impossible for us to transfer funds successfully to India. Even organizations that have valid and updated FCRA numbers have not been able to receive funds from us, regardless of the method we have attempted for transferring the money. In almost all cases, the funds are being returned, and most of the grant money is being lost to bank fees.

For these reasons, and until a solution can be found to the challenges we are experiencing, we have been obliged to suspend all funding to organizations in India.

We hope to revisit this decision in June 2018.

In the interim, OTF will maintain a waiting list of applications from India, which it will consider should secure funding once again become possible. If you would like to be included on this waiting list, please note the following:

ALL APPLICANTS FROM INDIA MUST PROVIDE A FOREIGN CONTRIBUTION (REGULATION) ACT (FCRA) REGISTRATION NUMBER

If an FCRA registration number is not included with the application, the request cannot be considered for funding. Any applicant organizations that do not have their own FCRA registration account may be considered for funding if they are able to provide an official letter from a duly registered organization that has agreed to accept grant funds on their behalf. OTF reserves the right to contact such organizations to confirm their credentials.
