The Ontario Teachers' Federation welcomes applications for grants from nationals of developing countries.

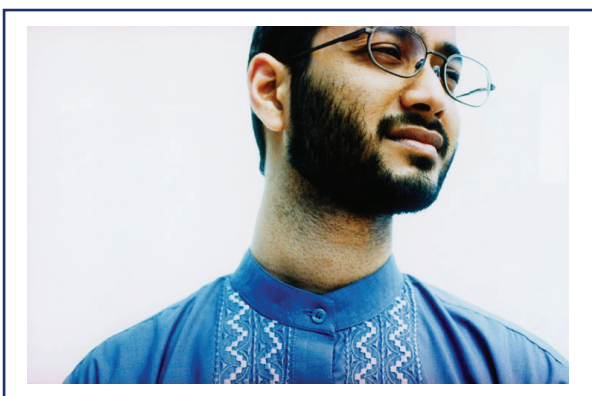
If you are a student or educator from a developing country who is temporarily studying or teaching in Ontario, you may be eligible for a grant from the Blanche E. Snell Estate Fund, a trust fund administered by the Ontario Teachers' Federation.

The primary intent of the Fund is to supplement and enhance the educational experiences of foreign students or educators who are temporarily engaged in an educational venture in this province, through related travel-study programs, workshops, conferences, or other educational endeavours.

The Fund may also be used in certain circumstances to augment grants that assist foreign students or educators to meet basic expenses such as academic fees, texts and accommodation.

The amounts awarded vary according to the individual requests, but are usually between \$500 and \$700.

There are no deadlines for receiving completed applications. The International Assistance Committee generally meets twice a year to consider applications (November/December and May/June).
