Why did we choose this learning?


- We wanted to explore BrightSpace Portfolio as a tool for pedagogical documentation.



We are going to walk you through the step by step process of opening and using BrightSpace Portfolio.


You will need: your iPad and class set of QR codes.

Click on the leaf icon titled "Portfolio". This will open the home screen where you click on the PINK "IN-CLASS WITH FUNSTER.








Scanning Your Class QR Code

Your class card will have your class D2L name on it.





Ready To Scan A STUDENT Pass Card


We are now ready to start collecting for a specific student. Find the student card you want to collect evidence for and scan their QR code by aligning the printed QR code with the outline on the screen.





Collect Picture Evidence





We are now ready to start collecting picture evidence of learning. Click the camera icon to open the camera.

There is no button to press to take the picture. Once the iPad is being held still, a counter will automatically count down from 3 and then take the picture for you!







The app will ask you, "Do you like the way this looks?" You can press the checkmark to indicate "Yes, I like the way this looks!" or press the X to go back and take the picture again.

This is Where We Add Student Voice!

Clicking on the microphone symbol will begin the recording of student voice. They can explain what they made, the process, what they learned, what goals they met, or anything they want to share!



While Recording...





While the students are recording their voice, the sound wave at the bottom of the screen will move with their voice. When they are done recording, press the thumbs up.



The Monster is "Sleeping" Again


After you press the thumbs up button, the monster will go back to sleep and wait to be woken up by the next student.


Click on the leaf icon titled "Portfolio". This will open the home screen where you click on the White "IN-CLASS MODE".



Collect Picture OR Video Evidence



We are now ready to start collecting picture or video evidence of learning. Click the camera icon to take a still picture or press the red dot to begin recording a video.









Ready To Add to Portfolio?


Once you are in the child's portfolio you selected, you may click the BLUE "Add to Portfolio..." button.


You will see a message that the "Evidence uploaded successfully" and you will be able to immediately view it in a student's portfolio. It does not need to be approved.





Each child's portfolio will appear in alphabetical order, by last name.




Select the piece of Documentation you wish to review.



In this top section there is a space to provide information/feedback regarding the learning or activity. The Teacher Feedback box under the "Student & Parent" heading, is visible to the child/family when the evidence is approved.



Student & Parent Teacher Feedback Provide the student with some feedback. Type a comment or feedback ... Neer Only The Teacher only site can be used for private notes/reflection that are not visible to the student/family even when the evidence is approved








Curriculum connections/categories can be tagged.


Approving Evidence

If a piece of evidence was added within the web based site directly on D2L it will be automatically approved and viewed by parents. In addition, you can also approve the evidence from the following screens:




Approving Evidence
