

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT SUBMISSION DEADLINES

The school year in Canada runs from September to June.

Requests for funding from the OTF International Assistance Fund will not be processed during the summer months (June-August). Applications will only be accepted commencing September 15.



Deadlines for applications

The International Assistance Committee meets twice a year to consider applications for project funding.

- First meeting takes place in early December.
 Applications must be received no later than November 1.
- Second meeting takes place in early June. Applications must be received no later than May 1.

If your application is received by OTF after the deadline date for the first meeting (November 1), it will be held on file for consideration at the second meeting.

If your application is received by OTF after the deadline date for the second meeting (May 1), it will not be carried forward to the next fiscal/budget year. A new application must be submitted.

Communication of funding decisions

All applicants will be contacted approximately one month following the meeting at which the project request has been considered to let them know the outcome of the Committee's decision.
