Full-time program offered on 3 campuses:

- Ottawa: 368 students

Alternatives to the full-time program

Part-time online: 132 students

- 3 year program
- Allows for more flexibility for students who need a better work/study balance

Combined Bachelor in French Literature and B.Éd.: 44 students

- 5 year program
- Placement during year 4 and 5

Practicum

For full-time students:

- Semester 1: 4 weeks
- Semester 2: 4 weeks
- Semester 4: 9 weeks

Second year students can do a community placement or have a year/semester abroad and follow their courses online.

The students are required to complete 80 days of placement.

Associate teachers are awarded \$40/week to host a placement student.

Seminar 2018

With the help of community partners, the Faculty of Education has organized, in Ottawa, a two day seminar for their 2nd year students. They were able to chose presentations that were relevant and relevant to their career goals and professional development.

Alternatives to the full-time program

The Faculty of Education is currently testing a program combining the bachelor of education to other bachelors. Students would graduate with a bachelor of education at the same time as a bachelor of arts, sciences, etc...

The combined program would be over ten semesters and is scheduled to start during the 2020-2021 school year.

Standards

Academic standard:

- Students have to obtain the grade of 65% in every course to obtain their credits.
- Students have to obtain the grade of 70% in their specialized courses to obtain their credits.

Practicum

- Students are evaluated on 12 competencies evaluated by their associate teacher.
- Formative evaluations are provided to the teacher candidate throughout the placement to help growth and maintain high standards.

Practicum

Students will participate in a placement during all four semesters.

The students need to complete 96 days of placement in order to graduate.

Associate teachers are awarded \$56/week to host a placement student.
