
Have you ever wondered what subject/division associations are...and what they have on offer for you at your faculties and for OTF members at large? Well, wonder no longer.

As part of the program at the Symposium, you will have an opportunity on Saturday afternoon to visit with some of the 50+ members of the OTF Curriculum Forum, an umbrella network of the subject/division associations in Ontario.

And this is how the carousel will unfold:

- Subject/division associations will be set up either in small clusters or on their own in designated areas throughout Trillium Ballrooms A & B.
- From 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm, participants will self-select FOUR (4) different clusters of subject/division associations to visit, each one lasting approximately 12-minutes.
- At each sharing station, a representative from a subject/division association(s) will showcase their
 accessible/available resources and professional learning opportunities for faculty instructors and teacher
 candidates alike as well as their Curriculum Forum peers.
- Time will be provided for each subject/division association to share and address participants' questions.
