What We Did

Working in a collaborative learning community guided by the book, "Strive for Five Conversations," we incorporated new resources (games) to create fun, authentic tasks and games to (re)build confidence, competence, and passion for French Immersion.



Using games in our FI classrooms has reinforced the power of play-based learning in language development. We observed that students were more willing to take risks in speaking when the task felt purposeful and engaging. Games encouraged repeated use of key vocabulary and sentence structures helping students become more confident speakers as they interacted with peers in a low-pressure, supportive environment.
