Surviving the Holocaust, By Chance Alone: Max Eisen's Story is a three-module student program designed to specifically support the Ontario Ministry of Education Grade 10 History curriculum expectations on the Holocaust. This program includes guiding questions and activities that allow students to connect with the human impact of the Holocaust, deepening their understanding and going beyond memorizing dates and facts alone. Max's story is positioned within the larger context of the Holocaust, to illustrate the vast complexities of this period in history, while investigating the personal impact of these events on one family.

While this program was created specifically for Grade 10 history, there are many cross-curricular opportunities.

The program includes:

- a timeline
- maps
- historical, artefacts (photographs, objects and documents)
- recorded testimony
- direct engagement with Max through *Dimensions in Testimony*
