THE OTF CURRICULUM FORUM (FORUM)

provides a unique avenue for professional learning opportunities for, and collaborative networking opportunities among, the Subject/Division and Special Interest Associations as well as between the Associations and OTF. The Forum also provides an active and important liaison between the Associations and the Ministry of Education.

Members of the Forum are OTF, the four OTF Affiliates (AEFO, ETFO, OECTA, OSSTF) and over 50 Associations. There is an open invitation to all formally established Associations to be part of the Forum by applying to the OTF Executive. The Forum usually meets three times during each school year—fall, winter and spring.

Some of the more recent Forum topics include

- approaches to equity and inclusive education;
- children and youth mental health;
- learning and teaching with social media;
- workplace health and safety;
- teacher wellbeing;
- engagement and recruitment tactics and strategies for Associations;
- poverty in schools; and
- truth and reconciliation.

LE FORUM DU CURRICULUM DE LA FEO (FORUM) fournit une tribune qui favorise les interactions professionnelles entre les associations-matières, les associations de division et les associations d'intérêt special (AMDIS), ainsi qu'entre AMDIS et la FEO. Il assure également une importante liaison active entre les associations et le ministère de l'Éducation.

Les membres du Forum sont les filiales (AEFO, FEEO, OECTA et FEESO) et plus de 50 AMDIS. Toutes les associations dûment constituées sont invitées à se joindre au Forum en en faisant la demande au Bureau de la FEO. Le Forum du curriculum se réunit habituellement trois fois pendant l'année scolaire - en automne, en hiver et au printemps.

On compte parmi les thèmes les plus récents :

- santé mentale des enfants et des jeunes;
- apprentissage et enseignement avec les médias sociaux;
